In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour Court dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-2).

2.) Without impleading Kahlon Rice Mills, petitioner has claimed certain benefit before the Labour Court while impleading one Sarabjit Singh stated to be agent of Trading Company Commission. Without impleading concerned party and seeking certain relief before the Labour Court it has been rejected rightly as is evident from para 13 of the award. In fact in the cross-examination, petitioner has admitted that he has wrongly claimed ₹ 3,60,000/- as arrears of salary. When he has worked only from 1.9.2012 to 31.08.2013 with the Kahlon Rice Mills and not impleaded him as a party and merely impleading one Sarabjit Singh, that does not give any right to the petitioner to claim any relief against M/s Kahlon Rice Mills. In view of these facts and circumstances, petitioner has not made out a case so as to

interfere with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 21.11.2017.

3.) Petition stands dismissed.
