Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of Heavy Vehicle Driver in the Scheduled Caste Category, pursuant to an advertisement No.04/2017. He purports to have qualified the written test as also the driving proficiency test. Although his documents were scrutinized by the Commission, but he was not called for interview that was held w.e.f. 25.02.2018 to 01.03.2018. Thus, in the situation, the petitioner represented to the Commission, vide representation dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P3), so

as to ascertain the ground for rejection of his candidature. It is urged that process of selection has since been concluded and the recommendations have also been made to the Government, but the representation of the petitioner continues to be pending before the respondent-authorities.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also his representation dated 26.02.2018 (Annexure P3), shall be considered and dealt with by the Commission within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

That beings so, the petition is disposed of in the above terms.

In the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-Commission shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
