Mr. R.K.Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy furnished.

In the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statement(s)/counter affidavit(s), on behalf of the respondents, is indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is employed as Associate Professor (Geography) with the respondents-department. Pursuant to the order dated 23.05.2017 (Annexure P-3), he was transferred from Government College, Barwala (Hisar) to Government College, Tauru (Mewat). All what is urged by learned counsel for the petitioner is that as the petitioner is suffering from multiple health issues and is under treatment at Hisar, his prayer for re-

transfer to Hisar or at any nearby station be considered. He purports to have even represented to the respondents, vide representation dated 9.9.2017 (Annexure P-6). But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the grievance of the petitioner as also representation dated 9.9.2017 (Annexure P-6), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of 8 weeks from today. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event, the grievance of the petitioner is declined, the respondents-authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
