This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to sort out the differences between themselves and to issue appointment letters to the petitioners as Inspector Cooperative Societies in the Department of Cooperation, Government of Punjab.

Learned counsel for of the petitioners states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3- Director, Government of Punjab, Sports and Youth Affairs Department (Sports and Youth Affairs Branch), SCO No.116-117, Sector-34-A, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representations dated 04.07.2017 and 29.09.2017 respectively (Annexures P-6 and 7).

In the circumstances, respondent No.3- Director, Government of Punjab, Sports and Youth Affairs Department (Sports and Youth Affairs

Branch), SCO No.116-117, Sector-34-A, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the representations dated 04.07.2017 and 29.09.2017 respectively (Annexures P-6 and 7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
