In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the
parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners are employed as Conductors with the
respondent-department. The common grievance that they have is; that vide
order dated 8.3.2018/21.3.2018 (Annexure P-1), they have since been
transferred from Kurukshetra to Faridabad. The petitioners have questioned
their transfers on multiple grounds, and particularly, for these are alleged to
be against the transfer policy of the State.

In response, learned State counsel submits that in the matter involving similar issues, as regards transfer of the employees of the Transport Department, Haryana, this Court, vide order and judgment dated 01.09.2017, rendered in **CWP No. 17899 of 2017 (Rajender Singh VS. State of Haryana and others)** and other connected matters (Annexure P-4) as also the judgment dated 12.12.2017, in **CWP No. 24190 of 2017 (Dilbag Singh Vs. State of Haryana and others)** and other connected matters (Annexure P-6), had issued comprehensive directions to the department to deal with similar issues. Thus, he submits that the grievance/claim of the petitioners shall be considered in terms thereof, and respondents shall pass appropriate orders within two weeks from today.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that nothing substantive survives in this petition and the same be disposed of in the above terms.

Ordered accordingly.
