Petitioners were engaged as part-time Sweepers in the Education Department on 01.05.1990 & 01.03.1990, respectively. Concededly, the services of petitioner No.1 were regularized on 08.08.2014 and of petitioner No2 on 25.08.2014. The limited grievance that they have is; that one Shish Pal who happened to be the junior of the petitioners and was appointed on 01.01.1991, his services were regularized w.e.f. 01.03.1999. Thus, it is claimed that the petitioners too ought to have been regularized from the same date. The respondents purport to have been served even with a notice dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P6). But to no avail.

In conspectus of the above, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondent authority to consider the notice served by the petitioners, dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P6), within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event, the claim of the

petitioners is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
