In the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statement(s)/counter affidavit(s), on behalf of the respondents, is indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners are working as Peon/Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar/Water Carrier with the respondents-department and there services were regularized in the year 2014. The limited grievance that they have is; that persons who were appointed subsequent to the petitioners, they were regularized w.e.f. 1.4.2011. Thus, the petitioners too ought to have been regularized with effect from the same date. They purports to

have even served with respondents legal notice dated 11.01.2018 (Annexure P-5). But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with within a period of three months from today. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondents-authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
