(1) Counsel for the Bank states that the order dated 17.01.2018 has not been complied with. The petitioner has neither deposited a single penny nor has even applied for any One Time Settlement also. The outstanding loan amount is ₹ 50 lacs.

(2) In this view of the matter, no case to exercise the discretionary jurisdiction by this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution is made out. Rest of the issues as raised by the petitioner can be effectively adjudicated by the DRT.
