Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of official respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner prays for a direction to respondent No.5 to permit him to join duty in compliance to the order of his transfer dated 08.02.2017, and correspondingly requiring respondent No.3 to relieve him so that he could join at his new place of posting. Further, the respondents be directed to release his salary with effect from March 2017 to date, which is alleged to have been withheld without any reason. The petitioner purports to

have even served the respondents with a legal notice, dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P8). But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner, as also his legal notice dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P8), shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of four weeks from today. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
