1. The petitioner retired from service on 30.06.2017 as an Inspector in Municipal Council, Tapa. He availed two years extension in service after retirement as per policy of Punjab Government. He claims that his pension case has not been finalized so far and he is drawing only 90% of the pension. He has also not been given arrears of un-utilized earned leave of 637 days. He has not received his gratuity nor has been paid any arrears of DA and other amounts are also due as pleaded in the petition. Reliefs claimed are multiple.

2. The petitioner retired from the office of Director, Local Government Department, Punjab. The claim is for monetary benefits which appear prima facie justified there being no impediments in the way.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent-State to take

up the legal notice dated 24.02.2018 (Annex. P-2), to consider and decide the same without delay, by calculating the outstanding dues and the balance amount of pension and other pensionary benefits and pay the same to the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

4. With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of. In case the full payment of the outstanding dues is not made within two months, the amount in default will carry interest @ 9% per annum till payment.
