The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the Circular No.CBSE/AFF/CIRCULAR/16a/2017/1335026 dated 18.12.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) issued by respondent No.2 to all the schools/institutes affiliated to it to the extent permitting them to open outlets for the sale of books/stationary etc. being arbitrary and violative of their own affiliation bye-laws and against the rules of the Haryana School Education Rules, 2003.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that certain relevant data with factual averments could not be incorporated in the writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action by furnishing better particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
