By means of this petition filed in the nature of Public Interest Litigation a prayer has been made to issue a mandamus to command the respondents to complete the railway under-bridge at the Court road railway crossing (at level crossing No.B-89) by sorting out the issue of expenses to be incurred on shifting of the 11 KV power lines between respondents No.1, 2 & 3. The allegation is that on account of differences, construction of the railway bridge at the site in question has been stalled causing serious inconvenience to the public at large.

Today when the matter is called out, Mr. Sahil Sharma, learned counsel appearing for respondent No.3, states that 11KV power lines have been removed and, thus, now there should be no hurdle for respondents No.1 & 2 to proceed further in the matter.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 & 2, on the basis of the instructions, states that the project would be completed with a period of 9 months.

In view of the statement made before us, we find no good ground for this Public Interest Litigation to continue on board any more and the same is hereby disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for respondents No.1 & 2.
