Learned Counsel for the petitioners states that the residents of Village never appended their signatures to the Resolution in support of the bifurcation.

The State, on the other hand, placed on record an application, supported by various residents in support of the bifurcation, which is on record as Annexure R-3.

This raises very serious dispute on facts with which we cannot interfere while exercising the powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

We, therefore, leave it to the Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar (respondent No.3) to evaluate the grievance of the petitioners with regard to

the issue of bifurcation. The petitioners are at liberty to raise all objections and respondent No.3, while ascertaining the grievance of the petitioners, would at liberty to seek verification of the affidavits of the persons, who may have supported or opposed the Resolution, as expeditiously as possible.

Disposed of in the above terms.
