1. In this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari setting aside the impugned order dated 9.3.2018 (Annexure P-2) vide which the e-tender filed by the petitioner has been rejected.

2. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, perusing the present petition and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, we dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the present writ petition before the appropriate authority/respondent no.2 within a period of one week. It is directed that in the event of a representation being filed by the petitioner within the aforesaid period of one week from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order, the same shall be decided in accordance with law by passing a

speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as respondent no.8 within a period of two weeks thereafter from the date of receipt of the representation. The petitioner shall be entitled to lead any evidence to substantiate his claim before the concerned authority.
