In the present petition, petitioner has prayed for the following
relief:-

*“A. issue a writ of certiorari and / or any
other writ, order or direction in the nature thereof to
quash/set aside the impugned summons dated
01.12.2017 issued by, Asst. Labour Commissioner,
Gurugram, Circle-I and subsequent orders, including
order dated 12.03.2018 (a copy of the same was never
supplied to the petitioner despite repeated requests).*

*B. issue a writ of mandamus and / or any
other writ, order or direction in the nature thereof to call
for the records of the proceedings in the matter titled as
“Ms. Neetu Sharma Vs. Kendle India Pvt. Ltd.” pending
before the Asst. Labour Commissioner, Gurugram,
Circle-I;*

C. stay the proceedings being conducted in

violation of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, before the Respondent No.1 and restrain the respondent No.1 from taking any other coercive action against the Petitioner Company;”

On 01.12.2017 summons were issued by the Assistant Labour Commissioner. Consequently, it is learnt that adverse order has been passed on 12.03.2018 which is not placed on record. In the absence of 12.03.2018, order present petition cannot be entertained.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed reserving liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 12.03.2018 by producing a copy.
