Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is employed as a Lecturer in Psychology with the respondent department. She is aggrieved by an order dated 10.1.2018 (Annexure P-9), vide which she was transferred from Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Meham, to the office of District Education Officer, Rohtak. Ex facie, the order was passed almost three months ago, and in compliance thereof, the petitioner has since joined at her new place of posting. The limited grievance that she has is; that she was posted

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in a School, and, therefore, could not have been transferred to the office of District Education Officer, under the rules. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also to her counsel.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
