Mr. R.K.Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy furnished.

In the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statement(s)/counter affidavit(s), on behalf of the respondents, is indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners were employed as part time Sweeper-cum-Chowkidar/Water Carrier/Peon between 6.7.1995 to 1.1.2003. Their services were regularized w.e.f. 2014. The limited grievance that they have is; that persons who were appointed subsequent to the petitioners, have since been regularized w.e.f. 1.4.2011, therefore, the petitioners too ought to have been regularized from the same date. In reference to the order dated

18.07.2017 (Annexure P-4), and in particular to one Naresh Kumar, at serial No.24, it is urged, that even though, he was initially appointed on 1.3.2003, but his services were regularized w.e.f. 1.4.2011. The petitioners allege to have even served the respondents with a legal notice dated 8.2.2018 (Annexure P-5), but to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioners as also legal notice dated 8.2.2018 (Annexure P-5), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of three months from today. And, appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event, the claim/grievance of the petitioners is declined, the respondents-authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
