Petitioner is stated to be serving as a driver with PEPSU Road Transport Corporation since 2012. He was transferred from Patiala Depot to Faridkot Depot vide order dated 20.07.2017(P-3). The petitioner filed CWP No.22271 of 2017 challenging his transfer on medical grounds which was disposed of vide order dated 18.12.2017 (P-5) to pass a speaking order upon the representation of the petitioner seeking cancellation of his transfer.

In compliance an order dated 17.01.2018 has been passed by the M.D. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala revealing that the petitioner had been transferred on account of complaints against him with regard to other claims of overtime etc.. The issue has been addressed in the order.

By filing the present writ petition, the speaking order dated

Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no ground for interference is made out in the light of the fact that that the petitioner was transferred way back in 2017 on the grounds of complaint. It is conceded that the petitioner is liable to serve anywhere within the state and transfer is only an incidence of service.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
