This appeal has been filed by the claimant-appellants seeking enhancement of compensation awarded by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Sirsa (hereinafter referred to as 'the Tribunal') vide award dated 13.07.2016 whereby they have been awarded Rs.9,35,000/- on account of death of their son Ajay in a motor vehicular accident which took place on 18.07.2014. Appellants are the parents of the deceased.

The deceased was 18 years old and was unmarried. The Tribunal assessed the compensation as under:-

Sr. No.	HEADS	CALCULATIONS
(i)	Income	Rs.5000/- per month
(ii)	50% of (i) above to be added as future prospects	5000+2500=7500
(iii)	50% of (ii) above is deducted as personal expenses of the deceased	7500-3750=3750
(iv)	Compensation after multiplier of 18 applied	3750 X 12 X 18=8,10,000
(v)	Transportation and funeral expenses	Rs.25,000/-
(vi)	Love and affection	Rs.1,00,000/-
(vii)	TOTAL COMPENSATION AWARDED	Rs. 9,35,000/-

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the case file.

No further modification is required in the compensation in view of the judgment of the *National Insurance Company Limited Vs. Pranay Sethi and others*, Special Leave Petition (Civil) No.25590 of 2014 (decided on 31.10.2017).

Dismissed.
