1. Learned counsel for the petitioner produces an experience certificate dated 19.03.2016 bearing reference No. 159SDCPB which has not been placed on record although an experience certificate of same date carrying reference No. 160SDCPB has been placed on record as Annex. P-2. The one on the record is for two spells between 16.08.2010 to 15.04.2011 and 26.07.2011 to 30.03.2012 for teaching work as Lecturer in the Department of History purely on part-time basis. The experience certificate produced today is for the period 01.09.2012 to 18.01.2016 comprising 05 different spells. These experience certificates have been issued by the Goswami Ganesh Dutt Sanatan Dharma College, Palwal, Haryana. In the certificate produced today, it is written "Lecturer in the Department of History purely on full time temporary/Contractual basis". The photocopy of the experience

certificate produced today is kept on record as Mark 'A' but no sanctity is attached to the same for reasons that follow.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by his mistake document Mark A was not placed on record. Both these experience certificates; the one brought today and the other which is on record are not counter-signed by the Director Secondary Education of the concerned State even for CBSE/Central Schools & Navodaya Vidhalyas as prescribed in the criteria. Teaching experience must be earned for the post of PGT in the relevant subject. PGT is a qualification for teaching in schools and not in colleges, and, therefore, the experience gained by the petitioner in teaching is not relevant to teaching in a school. The teaching experience prescribed under the advertisement No. 4/2015 published on 28.06.2015 with closing date of receiving online application forms was 21.09.2015 and reads as follows:

“TEACHING EXPERIENCE

Experience wherever application will be considered, only after acquiring the essential qualification along with details of salary of the concerned post and the experience must be countersigned by the Director, Secondary Education of the concerned State even for CBSE/Central Schools & Navodaya Vidhalya. Teaching experience must be for the post of PGT of the relevant subject.”

3. The experience certificate; the one produced today reads as follows:

“Ref. No. 159SDCPB

Dated 19.03.2016

EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE

This is to certify that Sh. Satish Deshwal S/o Sh. Randhir Singh has worked in this institution as Lecturer in the Department of History purely on full time temporary/Contractual basis. The session wise details are as under:

01.09.2012 to 15.04.2013 8 months 15 days

06.08.2013 to 26.04.2014 8 months 29 days

01.08.2014 to 10.04.2015 8 months 10 days

04.08.2015 to 05.12.2015 4 months 01 day

18.01.2016 to continue 2 months

He bears a good moral character.

I wish him all success in life.”

4. The petitioner does not make good the eligibility criteria. He does not possess the requisite experience for the advertised post. The petition thus stands dismissed.
