This appeal has been filed against the award of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Mohali awarding a sum of Rs. 17,33,000/- alongwith interest at the rate of 9% per annum for the death of Tejvir Singh.

Counsel for the appellants has stated that the compensation awarded by the Tribunal is inadequate. Counsel for the insurance company has countered by arguing that the deceased was 19 years old and was stated to be working with his father on repair shop and though no evidence was led to that effect yet the Tribunal took income as Rs.9,000/- per month and gave 50% future prospects also.

In my considered opinion, there is no scope of enhancement.

The appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
