By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to forthwith grant and release the pending service dues of the petitioner qua senior/selection grade along with consequential benefits/arrears and interest by taking into account the total service w.e.f. 1979 till date of retirement into consideration in view of the settled legal position vide judgment dated 10.03.2016 (P-4).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 18.10.2016 (P-5) including legal notice dated 09.12.2017 (P-6) were made to the respondents but till date no action has been taken so far. He further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-6), within some specified period.

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3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 09.12.2017 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order particularly in view of the judgment already referred in the legal notice (P-6), within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
