of ₹80,000/- would be deposited in the name of appellant No.2- Nirmala
before the Lok Adalat Branch of this Court on or before 07.07.2018.

Learned Counsel for the appellant states that the appellant would abide with the terms of the compromise deed.

Accordingly, present appeal stands disposed of.
