1. Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical expenses to sum of Rs.1,50,2015/- incurred upon Raksha Kumari, wife of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice was made to respondent No.3 on October 07, 2017 (Annexure P-6) but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide his legal notice dated October 07, 2017 (Annexure P-6) within some specified period.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3-District

Education Officer, Tarn Taran to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated October 07, 2017 (Annexure P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
