Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for grant of deemed date promotion to the petitioner as AE, AEE, Xen with all consequential benefits of fixation of pay, re-fixation of pay, revision of pay from the date his juniors Sh. R.S. Malik was granted and payment of all admissible arrears on account of fixation/re-fixation of pay and allowances, retiral benefits, correct fixation of pension, arrears of pension and interest on the amount of all arrears to which the petitioner is entitled in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation was made to respondent No.3 on November 24, 2017 (P-5) but till date neither any reply to the said representation has been received nor any final order has been passed by the concerned Department.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide his representation dated November 24, 2017 (P-5) within some specified

period.

4. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3-S.E./Admn., Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam, Vidyut Sadan, Vidyut Nagar, Hisar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated November 24, 2017 (P-5) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
