For the reasons stated in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, delay of 1 day in filing the appeal is condoned.

Application is allowed.

Main Case

The plaintiff-appellant is in the Regular Second Appeal against the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by both the Courts below.

The plaintiff-appellant alongwith others being worshipper having faith in Gurudwara Guruteg Bahadur Sahib, filed a suit claiming declaration that the alleged exchange of land of Gurudwara with the defendants is illegal, null and void.

Both the Courts below after examining the evidence available

on the file have recorded concurrent finding of fact that the exchange was for the benefit of the Gurudwara and the exchange was carried out after passing the Resolution by the Local Management Committee which was also approved by Shri Gurudwara Parbandhak Committee at Amritsar.

In view thereof, there is no scope for interference with the concurrent findings of fact arrived at by both the Courts below.

Regular Second Appeal is dismissed.
