Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the advance notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-7) in view of the judgments passed by this Court in CWP No.1684 of 1997, CWP No.275 of 1998 and CWP No.4518 of 2000, which were attained finality vide order dated 11.08.2003 (P-4) and upheld by the Hon'ble Apex Court vide order dated 08.12.2015 (P-5) WITH FURTHER direction to respondents to restore the deductions made from the payment of additional dearness allowance w.e.f. 01.05.1973 onwards along with arrears.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforesaid advance notice (P-7) in view of the judgments referred in para 1 of this order, within some specified period.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the advance notice dated 15.02.2018 (P-7) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, rules and regulations, particularly in view of the judgments referred to above in para 1 of this order, which as per the version of learned counsel for the petitioners have attained finality, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
