1. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have perused the paper-book with the assistance of the counsel.

2. The petitioner has approached this Court challenging the termination order dated 29th July, 2016. The services of the petitioner have been terminated on the ground that the petitioner procured a job on the basis of a forged domicile certificate. Forgery has been proved. Besides, the dismissal order was passed on 29th July, 2016 and this petition has been filed on 28th March, 2018. There is unexplained delay and laches as to what prevented the petitioner from approaching Court in time. I find no ground in this petition to upset the impugned order which is accordingly dismissed.
