Petitioner is aggrieved by action of respondent No.3 as the partition proceedings are pending since 16.12.2016 and total 32 adjournments have been given but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is about 85 years of age and is having lesser land than his entitlement. The private respondents are cultivating more land than their share. The details of the adjournments given by respondent No.3 are mentioned in para No.7 of the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to respondent No.3 to decide the partition proceedings within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to make all efforts to conclude the proceedings preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
