Petitioner seeks issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant emergency parole to the petitioner under Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for 20 days.

Petitioner was convicted under Section 46 of the BSF Act, 1968, Section 302 IPC and Section 16(d) of the BSF Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleged that despite representation for grant of parole to the petitioner, the same has not been considered by the Authorities.

Learned counsel refers to the Panchayatnama where

the ailment of petitioner's younger son has been described and his need for immediate attention for heart ailment.

Learned State counsel submitted that no representation has been received by respondent No.4. As and when, the same is received, the same shall be dealt in accordance with law.

In view of above, let representation be filed by the petitioner within a week before respondent No.4. In the event of filing such a representation, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law within a period of 10 days after receiving certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
