Appellant-wife had filed a petition for decree of divorce in the Court of Additional District Judge, Hoshiarpur. The said petition having been dismissed, the wife has preferred this appeal. During pendency of the appeal, the parties are stated to have filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and the marriage is likely to be dissolved on the basis of the statement made before the Matrimonial Court on the date fixed i.e. 11.7.2018.

In view of the above said circumstances, counsel for the appellant-wife seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal without prejudice to the right of the appellant-wife to approach this Court for revival, in case the proceedings under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act

for any reason do not culminate into a decree of divorce within a period of 3 months after July 2018.

The appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.

Miscellaneous applications No.CM-25987-CII of 2017 and CM-25988-CII of 2017 also stand disposed of accordingly.
