Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical reimbursement certificate/medical bills (P-1) along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated 10.11.2017 (P-3) was made to the respondent No.2 but till date neither any reply to the said legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents. She further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide aforesaid legal notice (P-3) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Secretary, Punjab State Health System Corporation Limited, Phase-VI, Mohali to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 10.11.2017 (P-3) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid legal notice, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, competent authorities come to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the relief(s) claimed, same be released to him within a period of next one month. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
