Confined to respondents No.1 & 2 only, at this stage.

Mr. RK Doon, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner was employed as Extension Lecturer in Political Science at Rewari in 2014-15 & 2015-16, but due to no workload his services were dispensed with. Subsequently, in terms of the letter dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P3), he represented to the Director General, Higher Education, Haryana, vide representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P7), seeking readjustment. It is urged that the representation of the petitioner was

marked to the Principal of the College (respondent No.3) for taking appropriate action. And, vide yet another letter dated 7.02.2018 (Annexure P8), the Principal of the College was required to take action, in terms of point No.3 of the letter dated 20.09.2017. The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that his claim/representation is pending consideration before the respondent-authorities, particularly the Principal of the College, but has not yielded any tangible result.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondent-authorities within a period of six weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
