The petitioner was enrolled as a Home Guard Volunteer in the Chandigarh Home Guards Organisation under the Punjab Home Guards Act, 1947, on 6.9.1993. He was discharged from the rolls, pursuant to an order dated 11.7.2008 (Annexure P-5), for he was found creating nuisance in the barrack, after consuming alcohol in the day time. Ex facie, the impugned order was passed almost a decade ago, and thus, the petition suffers from gross and inordinate delay.

No ground is made out to interfere in exercise of extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
