The petitioner has filed the present petition for extension of parole period for further six weeks to complete the renovation work of his house as he was granted parole for a period of 15 days vide order dated 08.03.2018. Said period had already expired on 26.03.2018 and the petitioner had surrendered after expiry of period of said parole of two weeks.

No ground is made out to extend the period of parole as the petitioner is now in custody as he has surrendered after expiry of period of parole already granted to him.

However, in case, the petitioner is entitled for parole then he is at liberty to make a fresh representation.
