The only grievance of the petitioner raised in the petition is that in the statutory appeal filed by him is slated for hearing on 20.04.2018 along with the application for stay on which notice has been issued but in the meantime vide notice dated 22.03.2018 the petitioner has been informed that proceedings to dispossess him would be conducted upon a demarcation on 04.04.2018. The limited prayer before us is that in case the said proceedings are permitted to go on the same would result in his dispossession which would frustrate his statutory right of appeal.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the material on record, we would dispose of the present petition without issuance of notice of motion to the other side on account of the direction that we intend to pass mandating the Appellate Authority to decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible but not later than four months from 20.04.2018.

During the pendency of the appeal, the dispossession of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

Petition stands disposed of.
