Petitioner has been engaged since last 5/6 years as a Daily Wager for plantation purposes in the Forest Range, Tarn Taran. His grievance is that vide order dated 01.11.2017 he has been sent to work from Kasoor Drain in Gohalwar beat of Tarn Taran to Jagatpura Distributory although in the same Tarn Taran Range. The petitioner although had joined at his ordered place of posting, however, has filed the present petition seeking some adjustment in view of he suffering hardship of travelling almost 40kms from his place of residence everyday.

Mr. Manoj Bajaj, Additional Advocate General, Punjab was requested to verify the facts.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Baljit Singh, Forest Block Officer, Tarn Taran submits that

keeping in view the seasonal nature of plantation of trees, the petitioner was

shifted to the said beat in November 2017, however, as and when some work is available at his place near his residence, his case for adjustment shall be duly considered.

In view of the above, no ground for interference exists.
