The present appeal is directed against the award dated 07.08.2015, passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Fatehgarh Sahib (for short, the Tribunal).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company submits that the appellant is aggrieved only with regard to the award of compensation of ₹5,04,000/- on account of disability suffered by respondent No. 1/claimant as there was nothing on the record to prove that respondent No. 1 ever suffered any disability. According to learned counsel for the appellant, for the injuries suffered by respondent No. 1, under the aforesaid head he should have been granted only ₹2,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 submits that the above amount of ₹2,00,000/- in lieu of the granted amount of ₹5,04,000/- is acceptable to respondent No. 1.

In view of the above agreement, the amount of ₹5,04,000/- granted by the Tribunal for the disability suffered by respondent No. 1 is reduced to ₹2,00,000/-.

The present appeal is disposed of in the above terms.
