REKHA MITTAL, J. (Oral)

The claimants are in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of death of Jagdev Singh in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 23.07.2015.

The Tribunal has awarded compensation of Rs.4,55,000/-, detailed hereunder:-

1. Annual income of the deceased	Rs.60,000/-
2. Multiplier	7
3. Deduction for personal expenses	1/4 th
4. Loss of dependency	Rs.3,15,000/-
5. Expenses on funeral	Rs.25,000/-
6. Loss of estate	Rs.5000/-
7. Loss of consortium	Rs.1,00,000/-
8. Loss of love and affection	Rs.10,000/-

Taking a clue from notification fixing minimum wage coupled with age of the deceased who was 62 years old, income of the deceased is assessed at Rs.6000/- per month. The multiplier and deduction for personal expenses allowed by the Tribunal are correct and affirmed. In this manner, loss of dependency is calculated at Rs.3,78,000/- [(6000 x 12 x 7) – (1/4th deduction for personal expenses)].

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.1,40,000/- under conventional heads and the same is affirmed.

Total compensation is Rs.5,18,000/- and the additional amount

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is Rs.63,000/- (5,18,000 – 4,55,000), payable with interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization, to widow of the deceased.

The appeal is partly allowed in the aforesaid terms.
