This is an application for pre-poning and disposing of the appeal in terms of the compromise between the appellants/claimant and applicant/respondent No.3-Insurance Company.

Heard. So far as request for preponing the case is concerned, same has now become infructuous as main case is also listed today. However, application for deciding the case on the basis of compromise is allowed.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Co. states that the matter has been compromised with the appellants fully and finally for a total sum of ₹3,25,000/- and they are ready to pay the said amount through
