The petitioners pray for a direction to the respondents to consider their claim for awarding them five non-compounded advance increments, for they possessed Ph.D. degree at the time of their regular appointment as Assistant Professors w.e.f. 16.3.2015, with all consequential benefits. They purport to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard, but to no avail. Even the legal notice, dated 4.12.2017 (Annexure P-8), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners, as also their legal notice, dated 4.12.2017 (Annexure P-8), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. In the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order, assigning reasons in support thereof.
