Mr. R.K. Doon, AAG., Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies supplied.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner competed for selection to the post of TGT (Physical Education), in the General Category, and qualified the written examination, that was held on 20.12.2015. However, he did not participate in the scrutiny of documents, for he had not qualified the requisite examination, i.e. HTET. But, the note appended with the eligibility clause in the advertisement (Annexure P-1), at page 15, postulates that even those candidates, who qualified the HTET examination even till the date of interview, shall be permitted to participate in the interview.

And, for the petitioner qualified the said examination in December, 2017, and the interviews are yet to take place, it is urged that he has a right to be considered for selection.

In response, learned State counsel submits that claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner as also to his counsel, before the interviews are held.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. In the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
