Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that passport has not been issued to the petitioner despite the fact that he was released on probation by the court of Addl. Sessions Judge, Fatehabad pursuant to trial which ensued as a result of FIR No.305 dated 31.10.2007, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel appearing for Union of India, however, submits that the petitioner has not yet submitted any reply to the query raised by the passport office vide letter Annexure R-1. He submits that in case petitioner submits that reply within two weeks from today, his case shall be reconsidered by the Passport Authority and a speaking order shall be passed.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. Petition is disposed of.
