This is a petition against a transfer order. The petitioner after having served in one school for nearly 08 years has been transferred to school which is only 20 kilometers away from the present place of posting. No prejudice has been shown to have caused to the petitioner nor any *malafides* are alleged against any authority. Some inconvenience is always involved in postings and transfers.

Needless to say that if the petitioner has any genuine grievance as contained in her petition, it is for the authorities in the first instance to examine and decide that. The petitioner would be heard on her grievance and the decision will be taken. The petitioner will make a composite representation before the competent authority by Monday i.e. 30.04.2018 and the authorities will decide the representation within one week thereafter.

The petition stands disposed of.
