Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order dated 30.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2-Regional Deputy Director, Local Government-cum-Collector, Patiala under the Punjab Public Premises and Land (Eviction and Rent Recovery) Act, 1973 (for short 'the Act').

Vide the said order, the petitioner was ordered to be evicted from the property of respondent No.3-Municipal Council, Sangrur. As per provisions of Section 9 of the Act, an appeal lies from every order of the Collector made in respect of any public premises under Section 5 or 7 to the Commissioner.

Counsel could not dispute the above said aspect.

Faced with this situation, counsel does not wish to press the present writ petition and prays for liberty to avail of his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Ordered accordingly.
