JASPAL SINGH, J.

Through instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to release pay scale of the post of RO as per notification (P-1) duly corrected thereto by the Court vide order and judgment dated 14.10.2015 passed in CWP No.16987 of 2015 with consequential relief.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents to decide their representation dated 25.01.2018 (P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to

look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in representation dated 25.01.2018 (P-4) and to decide the same in the light of judgment passed by this Court in *CWP No. 10505 of 2017 (O&M)*, titled as “*Major Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another*”, decided on 17.05.2017 (P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the concerned authority, they shall be at liberty to have recourse to the remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
