This appeal has arisen from the judgement and decree dated 5.2.2015 passed by the Additional District Judge, Yamuna Nagar by which a petition filed under Section 12 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [for short 'the Act'] by the respondent-wife for annulment of the marriage has been allowed.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that although the interim stay was granted on 28.5.2015 yet the respondent-wife, after obtaining the order of stay has remarried.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that he could not contact the appellant and has therefore, prayed that the present appeal may be dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to get it revived in case the appellant still has some interest left in this appeal.
