The present writ petition has been filed for quashing of orders dated 04.10.2016 and 27.11.2017 (Annexure-P10 and P11 respectively).

From the perusal of the order (Annexure P-11) it is evident that the matter has been remitted back to Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Rampura Phul to re-decide the matter after hearing parties and considering the evidence.

During the course of arguments, counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer that during the pendency of the remand proceedings the status-quo should be maintained.

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No interference is called for at this stage. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to make such a prayer before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade/Sub Divisional Magistrate, Rampura Phul.

There is no doubt if such an application is made, the respondent will consider the same in accordance with law.
