Petitioner-Monu Swami seeks two weeks parole for performing the rites and rituals on account of death of his mother who is stated to have expired on 25.3.2018.

Ms. Kirti Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana representing the State has today filed a report of ASI Satyapal, Police Station City, Narnaul wherein it has been verified that mother of the petitioner had expired on 25.3.2018. She has further submitted that as per her instructions, the applicant is not involved in any other case.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has restricted his prayer for release of the petitioner for two days only and that too while in custody.

In view of the aforesaid limited request and bearing in mind that the mother of the petitioner has expired and the petitioner would be

required for performing some rites and rituals, the petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on “temporary release” for two days for performing the last rites of his mother. He shall be taken to his native village in Narnaul in custody on the morning of 10.4.2018 and shall be consigned back in jail on the evening of 11.4.2018.

The petition is disposed of in above terms.
