By virtue of the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant him the benefit of selection grade w.e.f. 01.01.1996 instead of 01.08.2000 with all consequential benefits in compliance of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.9347 of 2016 decided on 20.02.2017 (P-9) WITH FURTHER to decide the legal notices dated 16.11.2017, 30.11.2017 and 12.02.2018 (P-11 colly) along with interest @ 12% per annum and further to refix the pay and revise the pension.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though various legal notices dated 16.11.2017, 30.11.2017 and 12.02.2018 (P-11 colly) were made to the respondents but till date no final decision has been

taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.11.2017 (P-11) within some stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 16.11.2017 (P-11) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and insructions issued by the Government from time to time particularly in view of the judgments referred to above in the legal notice, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
